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A permit fee of \$30.00 has been received.

The permitted work shall commence **8/26/2016** and shall be diligently prosecuted to completion. The work shall be completed and all disturbed surfaces or objects restored on or before **8/29/2016**. In the event work is commenced under this Permit and the permittee fails or refuses to complete the work, UDOT may, at its election, correct any deficiencies or otherwise complete the permitted work at the expense of the permittee. Upon receipt of an invoice of the costs incurred by UDOT, permittee shall immediately pay the amount due. If an action is required to be filed in court to collect the amount due, permittee shall be liable for UDOT's costs and fees, including attorney's fees.

Before work permitted is commenced, the permittee shall notify Station Supervisor (Listed below).. By applying for the Permit and UDOT issuing the Permit, permittee will comply with all instructions, conditions, requirements, and regulations of UDOT with respect to performance of the work described in the Permit. Permittee will properly control and warn the public of said work within UDOT's rights-of-way to prevent any accidents. Permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless UDOT from all damages or claims, including attorneys fees, arising out of any and all actions performed under this Permit by permittee, permittee's employees, agents or contractors, including failure to comply with terms and conditions in this Permit. Permittee shall pay for UDOT's inspections fees.

Permittee shall hold an insurance policy in the amount of \$1,000,000.00, as determined by the Regional Director/District Engineer.

Permittee shall not perform any work on state highway rights-of-way beyond those areas of operation described on this Permit.

If permittee fails to comply with UDOT's regulations, specifications, or instructions pertinent to this Permit, the Region Director/District Engineer or his duly authorized representative, may by verbal order, suspend the work until the violation is corrected. If permittee fails or refuses to promptly comply, the Region Director/District Engineer or his authorized representative may issue a written order stopping all or any part of the work. When satisfactory corrective action is taken, an order permitting resumption of work may be issued.


Special Limitations:

- Traffic control devices to be provided by Permittee. Permittee is responsible to contact local law enforcement to coordinate implementation of traffic control plan.
 - Use current edition of UDOT standard drawing for traffic control. Use Utah MUTCD standards for traffic control elements not shown in UDOT standard drawings. Traffic control must be posted at the encroachment site for entire encroachment period.
 - Contact station foreman before starting project.
 - Traffic Control Plans, signs and channelizing devices must conform to MUTCD Standards, as a minimum, and all signs must be equipped with three orange flags.
 - This agreement and/or permit is UDOT approval only. You are responsible to obtain clearances from railroads, private property owners and local jurisdictions that you are working within.
 - ANSI 107-2004 Class II clothing (or greater) is required of all workers within the right-of-way.
 - Notify UDOT upon completion of project for inspection.
 - All riders must ride no more than two abreast and must not impede traffic if doing so.
 - Applicant certifies that all participants have signed a Waiver and Release of Damages against the State of Utah for participation in an approved special event on State Roads.
 - Bikers are expected to wear reflective clothing when riding at night. Bicyclists must be equipped with a white light on the front and a red reflector on the back of their bike.
 - Licensee will be responsible to clean up the highway after the event.
 - In Utah, a bicycle is considered a vehicle and must abide by the same rules of the road.
 - Snell, ANSI, or ASTM approved helmets must be worn by all participants.
 - No pavement markings or removal of signs are allowed.
 - By the accepting this permit, the Applicant acknowledges the hazardous nature of the work and agrees to assume full responsibility in the event of an accident or other incident involving death or injury to members of the Permitess Group or others, or property damage that results from negligence or intentional conduct on the part of any member of the group.
- This is a rules of the road ride. All participants must observe all normal traffic laws and rules or risk being disqualified from this event and the event organizer may be denied access to state roads for future events if the traffic laws and rules are violated.

By carrying out the activities allowed by this permit it is conclusive evidence that I have accepted all provisions, limitations, and restrictions of the permit and attachments, understand and agree to all penalties for failing to comply with them, and understand my ability to review a permit and applicable attachments at the appropriate region/district office.
